“Opportunities in Transportation for Economic Development” Guest Speaker: Tom Skancke

For nearly two decades, Tom Skancke has been the lead advisor on hundreds of transportation infrastructure projects throughout the west and nationally. He is widely recognized as one of the top transportation strategists in the U.S., whose vision is transforming the way surface transportation is perceived and marketed throughout the country. In 2005, U.S. Senate Majority Leader Harry Reid appointed Tom to the National Surface Transportation Policy and Revenue Study Commission, which made landmark recommendations to Congress on policy, funding and infrastructure that will serve the nation for the next 50 years. Tom has previously served on the State of Nevada Blue Ribbon Task Force on Transportation, and the CANAMEX Corridor Coalition, a five state effort that looked at commerce, tourism, and transportation infrastructure in Arizona, Nevada, Utah, Idaho and Montana, and Governor Gibbons’ Transportation Transition Team, which helped prioritize infrastructure issues. Tom has also served on the Board of Advisors of the North American Center for Transborder Studies and has played a key role in the passage of important transportation authorization legislation. Tom is a graduate of the University of Nevada Reno, with a Bachelors of Science in business administration.
